Brief background on Kinship for Humanitarian Social Holistic Intervention in India (KHUSHII)

- Organise and facilitate exposure visits to enhance beneficiary understanding of various trades and of professionalism. Identify, recruit and manage mentors for beneficiaries to ensure that they access work-related coaching.
- Manage and supervise interns and volunteers that are associated with the Livelihood Program.

- Submit monthly report of programme activities.
- Document beneficiary successes related to the livelihood program for the organisations marketing collaterals
