 - Ensuring periodic presentations for the donor partners to keep them updated on the project supported by them
 - Assist the Fundraising team in pitching to existing and new partners.
 - Taking briefing from CP and donors to create and submit the new proposal within the given timeframe.
- **e.** <u>Stakeholder Engagement-</u>Facilitating stakeholder linkages with regional managers and coordinators. Identifying spaces for advocacy on identified themes and collaborating with stakeholders.
