Understanding Manobal and why it is important.



Australian Government

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, envisages building character, holistic and well-rounded individuals equipped with the key 21st century skills such as communication, cooperation, team work and resilience. Within the purview of NEP, and through our own observations and interactions we pivoted towards adoption of mental health and well-being as a key approach towards holistic education. Our intervention shaped into a flagship prorgramme Manobal which intends to sensitise and phycho-educate teachers.

Impediments towards Holistic Education and Mental Well-being





15% of the population faces mental health challenges



Majority of mental disorders surface between ages 11-18



13 million children aged **10-14** are living in poverty (2022)



1 in 7 youths aged 15-24 experience mental health issues



Only **41%** recognize the need for support



Many challenges remain unaddressed due to ignorance and stigma



95% of people with mental health concerns receive no treatment

Determinants



Government Schools

70.3% of children are enrolled in government schools, which allows us to tap into their well-being



Mental health of teachers

Research points out that teachers with low mental health are more likely to experience burnout and may create difficulties for the students. This emphasizes the importance of prioritizing teacher well-being, as their mental health directly influences the learning environment. Furthermore, Indian teachers have expressed mixed to negative attitudes towards children with behavioral struggles and their inclusion in the classroom, aggravating their issues.

Process



Identification of Batches Scheduling of Online Training



Pre-Assessment on parameters, including Knowledge, attitude, beliefs & behaviors



Deliivery of online training: 5 hour module over three days in batches



Post-Assessment on parameters, including Knowledge, attitude, beliefs & behaviors



Booster training session: In Person 90 minutes hands on training module



Follow up Assessment of classroom behavior of teachers

Observed impact on Teacher's classroom behavior

40 Teachers observed

10 Schools covered

Subjects taught by participants: Social, Science, Language, Mathematics, etc.. Higher score indicates better classroom behavior

Difference is statistically significant, means could not have occured by chance




Impact on Knowledge of Mental wellbeing






