EDUCATION INITIATIVES:



NIPUN Examination:

The Nipun Mission, an initiative of the Central Government, focuses on assessing students'

understanding of foundational concepts in reading, writing, and arithmetic for Classes 1 to 5 under the **National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy (NIPUN).**

On 21 December 2024, the Nipun examination was conducted for Class 1 and Class 2 students at **Primary School Naipura Kalan Daffi. Varanasi.** All students declared proficient.

SHIKSHA AUR VIKAS - PADS FOR FREEDOM:



About 53 sessions were conducted across 24 schools, empowering 10,949 beneficiaries, including girls (menstruators and pre-menstruators),

boys, and mothers, with vital knowledge about menstrual health and hygiene.



INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENTS:

STEM Success: Harsh from Rajkiya High School won accolades for his Road Safety Model at a science competition, guided by KHUSHII's STEM mentor.



MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL-BEING:

In December, significant efforts were made to strengthen mental health and well-being initiatives:





